Carrier Logistics Names Cesario to Lead Operations

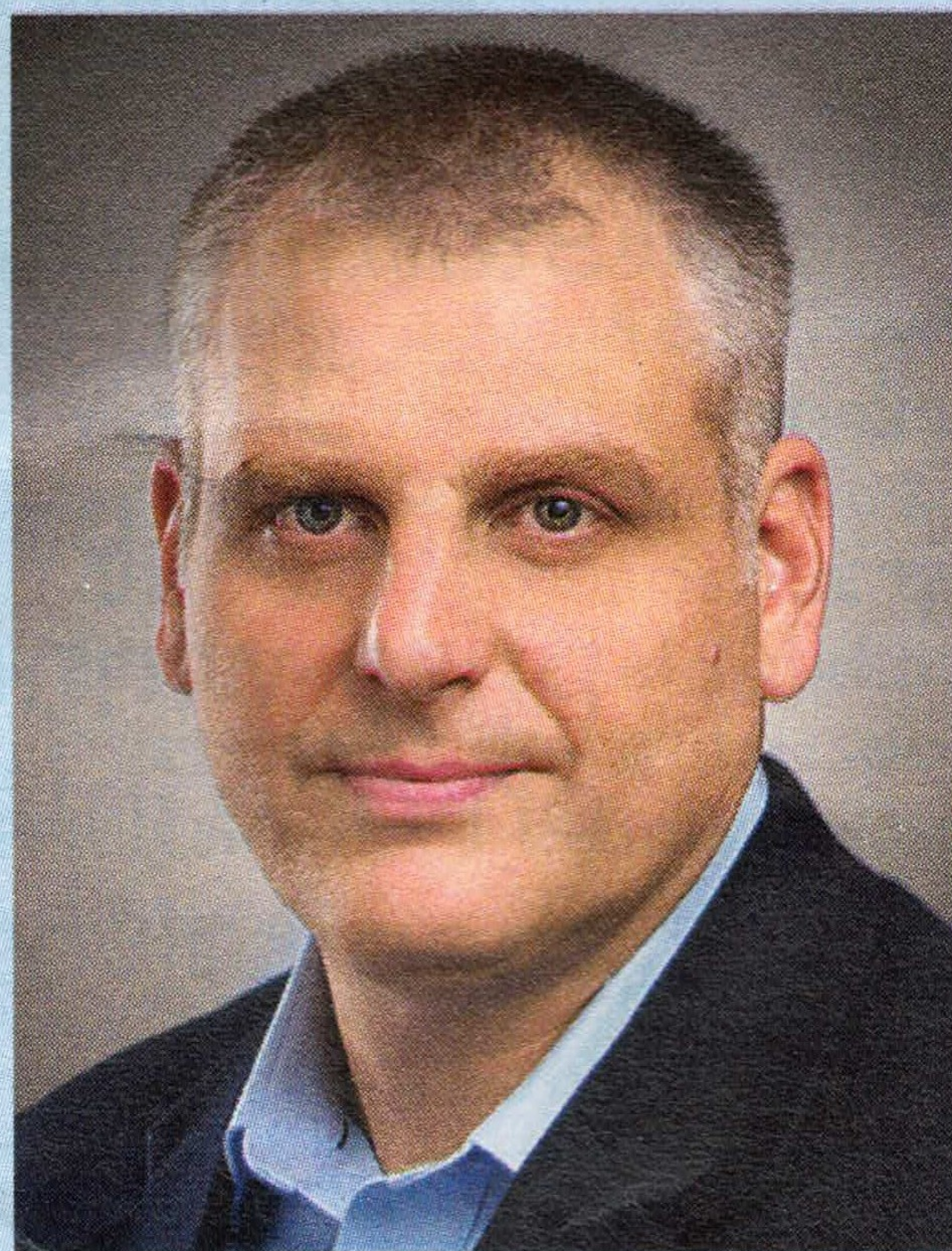
John Cesario has been promoted to vice president of operations at Carrier Logistics Inc., a leading freight management software provider for less-than-truckload fleets.
